

Adding Journal Articles to a List of Favorites


Step-by-step instructions for saving articles to your account for future access. If you have not already created a username and password, first create an account (journals.lww.com/pages/register) and activate your subscription (journals.lww.com/activatesubscription).

1. Go to “My Account” from  at the top of the journal homepage.








