

American Association of Neuroscience Nurses (AANN) NIWI Scholarship Application

Purpose:

Provide financial assistance to neuroscience nursing professionals interested in attending the Nurse in Washington Internship in Washington, DC in March 2021.

Scholarship Details: NIWI provides nurses with the opportunity to learn how to influence health care through the legislative and regulatory processes. Participants learn from health policy experts and government officials, network with other nurses, and visit members of Congress. NIWI is open to any nurse or nursing student (all levels of education) that is interested in an orientation to the legislative process. NIWI begins on Monday, March 22 at noon and concludes on Wednesday, March 24 with a closing reception at 5pm. For more information about NIWI, visit <u>this link.</u>

Amount of Scholarship:

The AANN NIWI Scholarship will cover registration, lodging, and travel expenses for one AANN member who meets the scholarship eligibility criteria. One scholarship will be available in 2021. The AANN Advocacy Committee will review all applications and select the applicants deemed most appropriate as the award recipient.

Eligibility:

- 1. Open to all neuroscience nursing professionals and students who are in their final Senior year and plan to work in Neuroscience
- 2. Current AANN member
- 3. Never attended NIWI in the past
- 4. Able to join the Advocacy Committee for a minimum one-year term following the awarding of the scholarship

Application Guidelines

- 1. One complete, **typed copy** of the grant application. **Hand-written applications are not accepted and will be automatically denied.** Applications with improper grammar and punctuation will not be accepted.
- 2. Personal Essays (using template below):
 - a. Essay #1 should describe reasons for interest in attending NIWI, including the presumed benefits professionally and personally. (250 word maximum)
 - b. Essay #2 should outline the applicant's interest and experience with advocacy. (250 word maximum)
- 3. Copy of nursing license or RN Certificate (international members) for regular AANN membership or name of institution and expected graduation date for Student Membership.

Deadline:

- 1. Completed applications must be received at the AANN National Office by email no later than Friday, January
- **22, 2021.** AANN only accepts submissions via email.

- 2. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

Review Process:

- 1. All applications will be blinded and removed of any identifying information.
- 2. Completed, blinded applications will be reviewed by the AANN Advocacy Committee and scored based on the applicant's compliance with eligibility criteria as well as professionalism, quality and comprehensiveness of response.

All applicants will be informed of the AANN Board decision by late February 2021.
