


Months in Reserve






Income vs. Expenses






Operating Revenue






Operating Expenses



- Survey closed on January 15, 2019
- Revised content outline will impact exams starting in fall 2020

- 444 applicants
- 276 new CNRNs
- 62% recertification rate
- 4,507 total certificants




